

Regional seminar on building digital library held at EWU

A REGIONAL Seminar on 'Open Source Software for Building Digital Libraries in South Asian Countries' held at East West University in collaboration with Digital Library Network in South Asia (DlnetSA).

The event was funded by Electronic Information for Libraries (EIFL). M.
