East West University holds 13th Convocation

13th Convocation of East West University was held on 24 February 2014 in the University's permanent campus in Aftabnagar, Dhaka. Mr. Nurul Islam Nahid, MP, Education Minister, presided over the function as the representative of the Chancellor Mr. Abdul Hamid, President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. Eminent litterateur and winner of 'Ekushey Padak', Ms. Selina Hossain was the Convocation Speaker. Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees and the Founder Vice Chancellor of the University, Professor Ahmed Shafee, the Vice Chancellor, members of the Board of Trustees, Syndicate, Academic Council, faculty members, graduating students and their parents, and a large number of distinguished guests were present on the occasion. A total of 1341 students received their undergraduate and postgraduate degrees through the convocation.

The Vice Chancellor in his welcome speech congratulated the graduating students for their academic successes. He thanked the Education Minister for his dynamic leadership that has brought about momentous changes in the education sector. The VC recalled important contributions that Ms Selina Hossain made through her writing towards raising awareness regarding contemporary social issues.

Dr. Farashuddin in his speech recalled how in less than two decades, the East West University grew from a small institution with about 30 students to its present stature of a leading university in the country with more than 8000 students and more than 300 teachers, besides hundreds of supporting staff. He declared that that the University continues to attract excellent faculty members and thereby attracting meritorious students from across the country. Dr. Farashuddin declared that the University's generous financial aid package supports large number of financially disadvantaged meritorious students, who would otherwise have missed the opportunity of higher education. He stated that these were possible because of the visionary approach of the founders and selfless dedication of the faculty and staff. Ms. Selina Hossain in her speech emphasized on character building, ethics and cultural awareness that needs to be embedded in education. She urged the students to establish their lives on high ethical standard and never to compromise on principles. She urged the students to help develop a multicultural, non-communal society where human values, rather than religious or ethnic identity will dominate.

The Education Minister in his speech lauded the role of East West University in promoting tertiary education in the country. He praised the University authority for building an impressive campus and ensuring a congenial academic atmosphere for the students. He stated that EW University could be a trend-setter for others to follow. He was all praise for the administration that has been generous in providing a large number of scholarships to the poor and disadvantaged section of the society. He congratulated the graduating students and wished them a successful life.

Four students were awarded Gold Medals for their outstanding academic performance. Gazi Esha' Islam from the BBA program achieved CGPA 3.99 (out of 4.00), while Ummy Habiba, Md. Nahid Hasan, and Afsana Umme Hani got CGPA 4.00 (out of 4.00) from the Masters of Science in Telecommunications Engineering program.

BoT Chirperson's Views Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin



What do you think about the current functioning of East West University?

East West University has been adjudged home and abroad as one of the best universities in the country. There is, however, no room for being complacent. EWU community should continuously

try to build on its strengths, and remedy the weaknesses. There is certainly a need to strengthen the teaching faculty, in many departments including Business Administration

(both BBA and MBA).

I recommend more intra-academic interaction. Furthermore, there is a need to expand extra-academic cultural and sports activities for helping the students build an attractive personality as well. There has been a lot of talk with regards to improving the English ability of the graduates. Unfortunately, adequate action has not been taken; more attention is needed in this respect.

There is an urgent need to create outdoor sports facilities for the students. With a reputation of a well known seat of higher learning, East West University should pay even more attention to management in general, discipline, punctuality and accountability in particular.

How would you like to see the University in the next ten years?

In the next ten years we expect East West University to excel in producing human resources of outstanding capabilities. EWU would become a centre of excellence in producing knowledgeable, dynamic and practical leaders to help veer Bangladesh to a position of High Human Development Index, HDI.

East West University should initiate effective collaboration and networking with high quality research bodies of the country and beyond. In the next five years, I presume EWU will emerge as a major seat of excellence in higher education in South Asia.

How do you advise your students to make use of their time?

Within the framework of a strong socio-economic progress in the country, the students of East West University would do well to take advantage of the educational facilities at this institution. Small size classrooms, comfortable learning environment, quality teaching, state-of-the-art laboratory facilities, digital library, scholarships and need based financial assistance, primary healthcare, insurance coverage and a lovely campus should motivate students to maximize their efforts in pursuing knowledge and transforming themselves into human resources of formidable quality. Students must be aware of -their rights in demanding the optimal quality education as well as their obligations to discharge their duties to the university, to their family and to our motherland.

East West University observes Independence Day

East West University observed the Independence Day of Bangladesh on 26 March 2014, commemorating the heroes who bravely fought against the Pakistani army, and made all kinds of sacrifices for the country's liberation in 1971. The independence of Bangladesh was declared on 26 March in 1971, which prompted the Liberation War. The people of then-East Pakistan took part in this war to liberate Bangladesh from the oppression of Pakistan. Independence for Bangladesh was gained through a nine-month civil war against the Pakistani Army, which resulted in the loss of about 3 million lives and modesty of 0.20 million women.

The Independence Day program of East West University commenced at its Aftabnagar campus, at the crack of dawn with the hoisting of the national flag. A prayer for war martyrs was also included in this program. The Chairperson of Board of Trustees Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, the Vice Chancellor Professor Ahmed Shafee, the Pro Vice-Chancellor Professor Dr. M. Sekander Hayat Khan, the Deans of different faculties, the Chairpersons of different departments, the Registrar, the students and the officers of the university were also present on this occasion. After this program, students left EWU campus for the National Pared Ground to join the national festival of "Lakho Konthe Sonar Bangla".

Dr. Anisul Haque, Professor, Department of EEE has been awarded the Gold Medal from Bangladesh Academy of Sciences for the year 2010 in physical sciences group (senior category). Dr. Shamsun Nahar Khan, Associate Professor, Department of Pharmacy has been awarded the Gold Medal from Bangladesh Academy of Sciences -TWAS (Third World Academy of Sciences) for her cutting edge research on enzyme kinetics and several other

innovative researches. The award ceremony was held on 20 April, 2014, Sunday at the Osmani Smriti Milonayoton,Dhaka. Sheikh Hasina, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh gave away the awards.

Professor Haque was cited for his research in the area of modeling, simulation and characterization of nanoelectronic transistors.

It may be mentioned that he is also the recipient of the University Grants Commission Award 2006 for research in engineering and technology.

Dr. Shamsun Nahar Khan is the holder of 7 patents and has authored more than 40 papers in international peer-reviewed journals. She is the recipient of several awards. Showing an uncommon enthusiasm for both chemistry and biology, Khan carried out a variety of interdisciplinary investigations, including anticancer studies, enzyme kinetics using chromatographic techniques, homology modeling, and pesticide and medicinal plant analysis. She eventually focused her efforts on the identification of enzymes associated with different clinical conditions and a kinetic study of enzyme inhibition.

Training Workshop:



The library has over the years built a robust collection of books, bound volumes, journals and news papers, and many other resources like theses, student's project reports, CDs and videos.

The EWU library (Block-B: 6th floor), spread over 10,500 sq. ft., also provides access to the best digital resources through its subscription to various databases consisting of scholarly science, business, management relevant content. The library has network to provide business, environment, agricultural, economic, and academic information to the users.

Digital Library

EWU Library is the first university library in Bangladesh that uses Greenstone Digital Library Software for building a digital library with a provision to implement Bengali version of this software. To maintain a world class standard, East West University Library has particularly chosen this software to build a digital library for this university. Greenstone Digital Library Software was successfully installed and implemented to serve the huge demand of digital information of the users as well as the intellectual community of the country. Primarily EWU Digital Library contains news clippings, theses and some other sample collections. Social Networking Window:

EWU Library introduced its Social Networking Window using facebook to provide specialized Information Services. Through this window anyone, particularly users of the EWU Library would get valuable information on different subjects, and updates about the library as well as EWU-for instance, notices regarding new arrival of library materials, events, news, seminars, workshops, library resources and services, and so on.

Collections

The general collection consists of approximately 25920 volumes, including scholarly books, reference books, textbooks, pure reference materials, journals, magazines, statistical publications, as well as current newspapers and periodicals. General collections of EWU Library comprise books and periodicals related to the field of Business Studies, Economics, Liberal Arts, Social Sciences, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Physics, Pharmacy, Computer Science, Mathematics, English Language and Literature, and Bangladesh Studies.

Books are placed in open stacks for the convenience of use and consultation. EWU Library maintains open access shelves to give enough choices to users so that they can select desired library materials. Users can go directly to stacks and look for their required materials. Library personnel are ready to assist in locating information, answer on-the-spot queries, guide and provide instructions in the use of catalogues, databases, resources, indexes, and abstracts whenever needed. Users can read books, journals, periodicals, newsletters, newspapers, etc. inside the library and are allowed to have books issued for use at home.

On the very next day participants went for Niribili Fisheries, where the manager of the factory showed around the hatchery and shared details about the overall operation. Then a short visit was made to Inani Beach and Burmese Market. The next day the team continued their trip to Chittagong, where they first visited Ambia Knitting and Dyeing Ltd and then T. K. Groups. Tour to "Ambia Knitting and Dyeing Ltd" was short but very valuable. Then the team went to T. K Groups, one of the biggest paper mills of South Asia.

T.K Groups was established in late 1900. It started with a mill and now on 48 acres of land it has seven mills with 15 hundred employees. Under one big factory house, there are eight subfactories in operation. Their smallest mill can make 30 tons of papers and the biggest one can make 500 tons of papers per day.

The team came to know about the main raw material to make papers, fiber, which is imported from Canada. Then the manager showed the visitors how pulp is turned to paper through machine. The Chairman of T. K. Group delivered a valuable speech to the participants.



Right now EWUBC is working on intra-university program design. The club is grateful to its highly esteemed moderators, Kashfia Ahmed and Md. Sajjad Hossain.
