EWU holds 23rd convocation

THE 23rd convocation of East West University was held on Wednesday at Aftabnagar sports ground in Dhaka.

Education minister Mohibul Hasan Chowdhury awarded degrees to 2,861 students of undergraduate and graduate programmes as the representative of the president, said a press release.

Four students with exceptional talent were honoured with gold medals at the convocation.

On this occasion, professor Mohammed Farashuddin, chief adviser of EWU and former governor of Bangladesh Bank, urged the government to grant permission for the initiation of MPhil and PhD programmes.

Later, Mohibul Hasan stated that some private universities like EWU had reached such a standard that the time had arrived for them to offer PhD and MPhil degrees.

The convocation speaker professor Alan McKinnon of Kühne Logistics University, Germany, opined that countries like Bangladesh were the worst victims of 'climate injustice'.
